



Petr Lubomír Štícha



He lives and works in Kolín (CZ), where he has his studio. **He studied art privately. In addition, he attended art history course at Charles University in Prague.** Creation of recent years are mainly oil paintings on canvas though he works also with other art techniques.

During all those periods his artistical main direction was "Surrealism". He let himself guide by drawings and ideas inspired by surrealism and even by visual elements and their composition interfering between fantasy and reality, thus giving the image of individual expression and style.

In 2014 he was granted the honorary membership in the Australian surrealist group "C. A. S. M."

Lebt und malt in Kolín (CZ), wo sich auch sein Atelier befindet. Studium der Fachrichtung bildende Kunst hat er privat absolviert. **Darüber hinaus studierte er Kunst-Geschichte-Kurs an der Karlsuniversität in Prag.** Seine Werke aus den letzten Jahren bilden Ölgemälde auf Leinwand. Dieser Wechsel in seinem Werk bedeutet nicht, dass alle andere Techniken unbeachtet bleiben.

Am meisten wurde der Autor von SURREALISMUS beeinflusst. Bei den Kompositionen schöpft er aus den Ideen, die in surrealistischer Epoche zu finden sind. Autor ergänzt die Bildkompositionen mit Motiven seiner eigenen phantastischen Realität, wodurch das Gemälde einen individuellen Charakter und eigenartige Handschrift bekommt.

The movement aims to bring external awareness and interest within the fantastic and surrealist art genre.

Purpose of the group:

1. Bringing together accomplished and committed contemporary artists from local, national and international talent pools within the fantastic and surrealistic art genre.

Our numbers are steadily growing. The artists involved at this moment are:

Austin Wilson I was born in Manchester, England but moved to beautiful Perth in late 2006. Although I'm just a beginner with my art I have a strong desire to express my views and opinions through subtlety and engaging surrealist art which stimulates and holds the interest of the viewer.

Chris Arnol Chris was born in Launceston, Tasmania but has been living in Perth for the past 5 years. Although fundamentally a figurative artist his work is influenced by his favourite genre, surrealism. Chris' work amalgamates the portrayal of an individual and the story they have to tell. The surrealistic twist hinges on the viewer's proximity to each work.

David Foster Retired 5 years decided to put some ideas to paint. Very keen on art history and surrealism. Has two City of Melville art awards and is an active member of C.A.S.M.

Ernst Schneider I teach Design and Technology and Woodwork at a private secondary school in the northern suburbs. In the last 4 years my passion for working with wood (mostly recycled timbers) and form has driven me to creating wood sculptures of a different kind, giving the wood a new unexpected lease on life. Sometimes a subtle splash of humour is embedded in my sculptures reminding us that life doesn't always have to be too serious.

Franci Hepburn Growing up on a farm in South Africa, I spent most of my time walking in the paddocks or staring at clouds. In 2002 I immigrated to Australia with my husband and children, where I continue to celebrate the sunsets. I paint what I see in the everyday world.

Gunter Lorenz In his surrealistic symbolic pictures Gunter predominantly puts man at the centre of attention. This move from surrealistic existence to dimensions where the personal dynamism of creativity produces new picture and space structures.

Lucia Moniewski Lucia Moniewski is an acrylic painter living in Perth, Western Australia. She has had a diverse career in education, principally in the primary sector. Her work received increased recognition and has won prizes in various community art awards. She has been a finalist (for 3 consecutive years) in the Black Swan Heritage Art Awards winning the People's Choice Award in 2013.

Michael McCartney London born, but an Aussie since 1967. Self-taught and ever learning. Each artwork is a moment in time, an original from the spontaneity of a thought – never to be repeated. I am a liberal, free thinker, very much a loner and individual, who tends to live more in the past glorious as it was, than to dwell on the future and its electronic past. My art has been sold direct to the public for well over 40 years.

Steve Dyer Before immigrating with my wife and 2 children to Perth in 1998, my paintings were shown in many exhibitions in the UK. Semi retiring last year I am mainly focused on my art and teach part time at the Metamorphosis Art Studio. I have won many art awards over the years and was awarded highly commended in the oil category at the Melville Art Awards, and a winner of the South Perth Art Award 2013.

Steven Pegg Plunge headlong into the intriguing world of my paintings where dream, thought and reality collide. Bold structures emerge out of striking vistas to make it feel as though the paint has escaped the confines of the canvas; floating before you in a space where you can reach out and touch it. I have always held an interest in art and my paintings have been shown in numerous exhibitions in and around Perth over the last 10 years.

Petr-Lubomir Sticha (Honorary Member) Lubomir lives and works in Kolin (Czech Republic, Europe) where he has a studio. He has studied art in the private sector and in addition he studied an art history course at Charles University in Prague. 


